Answer: *Zalophus californianus*

Answer: 11 months

3. What is the maximum diving depth that a California sea lion can reach?

Answer: About 900 feet

4. What is the average lifespan of a Bottlenose dolphin in the wild?

Answer: 45 to 50 years

5. How long are Bottlenose dolphins's fins regularly?

Answer: They grow to be 10 to 14 feet long

6. What carnivorous diet do Bottlenose dolphins primarily follow?

Answer: Fish, squid, and shrimp

7. What special communication method do Bottlenose dolphins use that acts like sonar?

Answer: Echolocation using high-frequency clicks

8. How frequently do Bottlenose dolphins shed their outer layer of skin?

Answer: Every two hours
